Simply conducting field studies does not ensure that we will achieve optimal educational benefits for our students. Instead of getting frustrated and angry, remember that this is how their brain works and how they learn.

The importance of building on previous experiences is relevant for adults as well. They highlighted these key abstract steps and signaled to the students that the steps would be relevant to the transfer task of writing debugging directions. If we don't want them to give up on themselves when things get too tough in the future, we have to build their tenacity. Knowledge representations are built up through many opportunities for observing similarities and differences across diverse events.
